## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



### Is this a new program for Fort Hudson?

YES and NO! Fort Hudson is excited to introduce SOCIAL Daycare to our service line – with anticipated program opening scheduled for June 1, 2008. Fort Hudson has offered a quality MEDICAL Daycare model since 1992.

### What is the difference between the SOCIAL and MEDICAL program?

The SOCIAL Program allows for supervision, case management, medication reminders, meals, activities, personal care, peer companionship, outings, and transportation. The MEDICAL Program provides additional support of professional and paraprofessional involvement including skilled nursing, medication management, wound care, ongoing clinical assessment, and optional physical, occupational, or speech therapy.

### Who does Fort Hudson Day Services serve?

Participants of our programs reside in the community, are 18 years or older, and may have a social, cognitive or physical need that requires support, supervision, companionship or medical intervention. Our programs serve the participant, as well as the community caregiver. It allows a caregiver to pursue work, school, vacation or errands during the workday.

### What are the Hours of Operation?

**Monday - Friday / 8 a.m. to 4 P.M.** Our programs offer *early and late pick-up*, as well as *full and part-time* options, to provide maximum flexibility for the participants and their families.

### How do I know which program is appropriate for me?

Fort Hudson is proud of our POINT OF ENTRY APPROACH to all programs on our campus. Our screening process works to identify the best program fit for each person's needs.

### Do you provide transportation?

Yes, utilizing Fort Hudson vehicles and lift-vans to accommodate wheelchairs and/or walkers if needed. We transport to points throughout Washington, Warren, and Northern Saratoga Counties. Transportation is included in our Medical Program rate; and is offered at ala-carte pricing for Social Program participants. Participants of either program may also arrange for their own private or public transportation, if they wish.

### How are the programs staffed?

The Medical Program consists of a Program Director (Registered Nurse), Licensed Practical Nurses and Certified Nursing Assistants – all meeting NYS Dept. of Health standards. Participants also have direct access to a full complement of clinical staff; including Physical, Occupational, and Speech Therapists, Registered Dietician, and a Certified Social Worker.

The Social Program consists of a Program Director, Personal Care Aides, Home Health Aides, or Certified Nursing Assistants – all meeting NYS Office of the Aging standards.

### How do I pay for either the Medical or Social Program?

The Medical Program is primarily paid through NYS Medicaid reimbursement (for participants who qualify for this funding). Private payment is also accepted. **2008 Medical Program Rate is an all-inclusive \$111.50 per day.**

The Social Program is covered through private payment, or a variety of funding sources through the local Office of Aging and/or Social Services Office. **2008 Social Program rates range from \$30 to \$65 per day, dependent upon services.**
