

# Updated Visitation Policy

**We are excited to welcome our families back to the Fort!**

Together, we must work together to make our reopening a success. This will require everyone's compliance with NYS Dept. of Health directives. Please note the following Visitation Guidelines for all visits to Fort Hudson Nursing Center:

- ✓ All visitors **MUST** be screened. G & S Wing visitors should report to the back of the building – to the designated Screening Area. A, B, & D Wing visitors should report to the front entrance – to that designated Screening Area. **PLEASE arrive 15 minutes prior to your scheduled start time** to allow time to complete required documents including a self-questionnaire, obtain a temperature check, and complete Contact Tracing Information (name, address, telephone, date, resident name).
  
- ✓ Visitors must be age 18 or older or be accompanied by an adult. Visits may extend to 30 minutes duration. Two (2) visitors allowed at any single visit. Our goal is one (1) visit per week per Resident during the initial phases of reopening (this is subject to change based on state directives).
  
- ✓ **DURING THE VISIT:** Visitors must hand sanitize prior & after visit. Visitors must wear a mask at all times and adhere to marked areas to assist with social distancing...**NO** physical touch will be allowed at this time. Residents will be masked (if able) or will wear a face shield. **NO** Restroom or on-unit access will be allowed for any reason. Distant visual monitoring will occur by staff to ensure compliance with all state guidelines.
  
- ✓ All visit locations will be fully sanitized per CDC guidelines.
