

# ATTENTION VISITORS

COVID 19 Infection is WIDESPREAD in the community, and transmission is occurring very easily.

Fort Hudson Employees are working tirelessly to prevent the spread within our facility - But we cannot do it alone.

While visitation is allowed at this time, we are **STONGLY RECOMMENDING** that visitation be avoided or minimized until the community rates of infection decline.

## IF YOU ARE VISITING, PLEASE FOLLOW THESE GUIDELINES.

- ✓ **GET VACCINATED AND BOOSTED!** If you are not yet vaccinated & boosted, you pose a substantial risk to our residents.
- ✓ **DO NOT VISIT** if you are not feeling well, been exposed or have tested positive.
- ✓ **KEEP YOUR DISTANCE!** Stay as far away from residents as possible.
- ✓ **WEAR YOUR MASK!** Please use surgical grade masks – cloth masks are NOT sufficient.
- ✓ **LIMIT THE NUMBER OF VISITORS!** We suggest no more than 2 visitors at a time to allow sufficient distance.
- ✓ If you test positive after our visit, contact the Nurse Manager **IMMEDIATELY** so contact tracing and testing can be started.
- ✓ Taking residents out to group settings is **EXTREMELY** risky

**If you have been in ANY group setting in the past several days without using masks, you are considered EXPOSED to COVID 19 and we ask that you avoid visiting for at least 5 days.**
