- 1. To obtain a Complaint Form from Fort Hudson, contact Fort Hudson Health System at 319 Broadway, Fort Edward, NY 12828.
- 2. In addition to the complaint process at Fort Hudson, complaints may be filed directly with the Federal Transit Administration, Office of Civil Rights, Region VII, 901 Locust Street, Suite 404, Kansas City, MO 64106
- 3. Complaints must be filed within 180 days following the date of the alleged discriminatory occurrence and should contain as much detailed information about the alleged discrimination as possible.
- 4. The form must be signed and dated, and include your contact information.
